

# Mentone Mustangs Covid Safe Plan

Mentone Mustangs is a Domestic Basketball Club participating in the Southern Basketball Association (SBA) competition held at 150 Tulip Street Cheltenham, and various other incorporated venues.

- Whilst PLAYING a fixtured game as a Mentone Mustangs player, you must adhere to and abide by all Covid Safe Plans pertaining to the venue you are at, and all SBA Covid Safe Protocols.
- When TRAINING, you must abide by the Covid Safe plan pertaining to the particular venue you
  are training at, PLUS the Mentone Mustangs Guidelines listed below.

Mentone Mustangs utilises the following training venues.

- Beaumaris Secondary college
- Parktone Primary School
- Parkdale Secondary College.

A QR code unique to each court of each venue must be scanned by the Training Adult (Separate to the Coach) and details entered for each player in attendance, plus the coach and yourself (Training Adult)

The Training Adult may be the Team Manager, or a parent of one of the players involved in the training session.

## EACH TRAINING SESSION MUST INCLUDE A TRAINING ADULT.

Training Adult must stay for the duration of training, ensure all players are scanned in using the QR code specific to the location of training. All contact details used for the QR code must be accurate and up to date.

### TRAINING SESSIONS

- Each player must arrive to the allocated training session with his/her own ball and filled water bottle. Please be punctual but not too early, as a previous session may still be running and create a crowding situation near entrances/exits.
- No parents, siblings or other spectators are allowed to enter the venue, unless your parent is the Training Adult for that particular session.
- Please sanitise in accordance with the training venue's protocols.
- Identify the **TRAINING ADULT** who will scan you into the venue using the Mentone Mustangs QR code unique to the venue and court you are training on.
- Remain a 1.5 metre distance away from your team mates as is practical, when listening to coach instructions.

**DO NOT** attend any training session or game if unwell. Stay at home and seek medical advice.

If you become unwell DURING a training session, alert the Training Adult immediately. You may
be moved to another area while your parent/guardian is alerted to your condition and you are
collected from training.

- At the conclusion of your training session, collect all belongings and sanitise as per venue protocol.
- Exit according to the venue information, along with your team mates, Coach and Training Adult.

#### TRAINING ADULT

- It is a requirement of Mentone Mustangs Basketball Club, that as part of our Covid Safe Protocols during training sessions, each team must have one (1) Adult must be present for each training session.
- For under 12 teams and below, a second Training Adult may be required.
- If you are the designated Training Adult, you may not bring other children into the venue.
- You must scan in every player using the unique Mentone Mustangs QR code to each court location.
- You must notify the contacts of an unwell player immediately, and isolate that player.
